



FAIR USAGE POLICY

This Fair Use Policy (FUP) is designed to guard against the improper use of both the internet and the C-Connect Sims. This FUP outlines the conditions that must be met in order to utilize the C-CONNECT Systems' and connection services, as well as your obligations and approved and prohibited uses of those services.

C CONNECT reserves the right and will take necessary action to prevent improper or excessive usage of the network service in order to help ensure that all users enjoy fair and equal use of the service and to safeguard the integrity of the network.

The action that C CONNECT may take includes, but is not limited to:

- 1.1 Throughput restriction, ie. the rate/speed of message delivery through the network channel;
- 1.2. Blocking or restricting network service through particular ports or communication protocols;
and/or
- 1.3. terminate the network service for users that, in the opinion of C-Connect, flagrantly misuse the network through incorrect or excessive usage.

This policy is applicable to both intended and unintended usage (for example the introduction of viruses, worms, malicious code, or other unknown reasons). Online activity will be constrained by the network's bandwidth, data storage, and other restrictions.

General

You are solely responsible for your conduct when using our network and any other systems that you access. Your access may be limited, interrupted, or terminated without prior notice if you use your connection carelessly or irresponsibly or if your activities jeopardize the reliability or security of the C CONNECT network, systems, or hardware.

You specifically agree that you will not use, attempt to use, or permit the use of your connection to:

- a) store, send, or distribute any content or material that is restricted, prohibited, or otherwise illegal under any applicable law or that a reasonable person would find offensive or obscene.
- b) maintain, send, or disseminate confidential information or data, intellectual property, copyright material, or other content that is subject to other parties' intellectual property rights.
- c) not engage in any conduct that could be grounds for legal action or that disparages, harasses, threatens, abuses, menaces, offends, invades the privacy of, or incites violence against, any one person or group of people.
